Although not fully finished yet the Family Support Centre has been used for two emergency cases:

A 16 year old girl was referred by her teacher after she shared that she was being blackmailed by an older man who threatened to share video of their sexual relationship on line if she did not go to live with him in Bangkok. He threatened that he was on his way to Sangkhlaburi to collect her.

She stayed at the centre with two One Sky staff who walked with her to school each day for 5 days until he was arrested in Bangkok by the TICAC team (Thai Internet Crimes Against Children).

The second case involved a 13 year old girl who had been repeatedly raped by her stepfather. After the girl and mother ran away the man kidnapped an older sister aged 19 who he also raped several times. He is a violent predatory pedophile who was in possession of two guns.

The family stayed for a full week before he was arrested and the family were reunited. We are now building the case against him and hope he won't be released for a long time.
